

Downey**, Assistant Special Agent in Charge, FBI Philadelphia Division to talk to us about the Public Corruption, White Collar Crime and the Civil Rights Programs that he currently supervises. Robert F. Downey ASSISTANT SPECIAL AGENT IN CHARGE

Mr. Downey was born in suburban Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, where he received his early education. He earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from West Chester University in 1976. Following graduation, Mr. Downey was hired by the Borough of West Chester Police Department. Mr. Downey served on the police department from August 1976 until August 1986, working a variety of assignments from initial investigations through criminal prosecution.

Mr. Downey was appointed as a Special Agent with the FBI in September 1986. Upon graduation from the FBI Academy, he was assigned to the Detroit Office where he conducted a variety of criminal investigations including violent crimes, bank robberies, fugitives, civil rights and drug trafficking investigations. In November 1990, Mr. Downey was reassigned within the Detroit Field Office to the Oakland County Resident Agency, Troy, Michigan where he conducted several Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) and multi-agency drug trafficking investigations.

In August 1995, Mr. Downey was transferred to FBI Headquarters and assigned to the Criminal Investigative Division when he assumed supervisory duties in the Criminal Syndicates Unit of the Drug Section. In September 1997, Mr. Downey was promoted to the position of Senior Supervisory Resident Agent for the South Jersey Resident Agency in Cherry Hill, New Jersey. The Resident Agency is responsible for investigations into violations of federal law under the FBI's jurisdiction in the southern New Jersey counties of Camden, Gloucester and Salem. In October 2003, Mr. Downey was promoted to Assistant Special Agent-in-Charge of the Philadelphia Division where he currently supervises the Public Corruption, White Collar Crime and Civil Rights Programs.

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE ISSUANCE OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships will be awarded annually. For the year 2010 Shomrim will be awarding two (2) scholarships. The amount to be given will depend on the amounts donated to Shomrim for this purpose.

The recipient(s) will be determined by the Board of Directors, with no more than one scholarship per family and recipient(s) will attend the Annual Banquet as our guest to receive the award. Recipient must be present at the banquet to receive the award.

Scholarships will be limited to <u>Active</u> members who have been in good standing for a period of at least five continuous years and their children.

Scholarships will be limited to students attending full time (day or evening) at an accredited College/University, earning an undergraduate degree.

The Scholarship Committee shall consider the applicants contribution and participation in the organization when awarding scholarships.

The following factors will also be considered:

Active members who are working and going to school full time.

Preference for applicants with no previous Shomrim scholarship awards over past recipients.

Applications must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee no later than April 15, 2010. Applicant should also submit a brief summary of past academic achievements, awards, and past and present extracurriculum programs they have been involved in.

Applicants having fully paid scholarships due to Regulation 32 or Hero Scholarship Award or having earned a fully paid tuition scholarship from any other source shall not be eligible.


