Passover Haggadah

On March 25th, we will be celebrating the festival of Passover; Pesach in Hebrew. It is the great spring festival that commemorates the Biblical liberation from exile and the exodus from Egypt.

For eight days(seven for the Jews who live in Israel and for certain Jews who live in the Diaspora) we eat Matzah, unleavened bread. This is in honor of the Israelites hurried exit from Egypt, in which they did not have time to wait for the bread to rise. The Bible tells us of the plagues that G-d inflicted upon Pharaoh, and his people in order to let the Israelites go free.

The telling of the Exodus story is the main theme that permeates throughout the Passover Seder that is celebrated on the first two nights of Passover (or just one for some).

We use a book that narrates the story of Passover called the "Haggadah". We fulfill the scriptural commandment to teach our children about the Jewish liberation from slavery in Egypt, as described in the Book of Exodus. The Haggadah also contains various rituals that involves traditional songs and stories and the use of symbolic foods. The word Seder means the "order" of the various rituals of the service. The Seder includes a festival meal. In addition to being one of the most celebrated holidays it is considered an integral aspect of the Jewish faith and identity. Unlike other public holiday observances, that are traditionally held in the synagogue, the Seder is usually held in the home. Passover is undoubtedly the festival that requires the strictest ritual observance. Not only from refraining from eating bread or any unleavened products for eight days, but ridding our house beforehand of all food not suitable for eating on Passover.

As we sit down and celebrate this beautiful holiday of Passover, let us remember all the members of our armed forces, who made the supreme sacrifice through the years and through the conflict that we are experiencing today, so that we can be with our loved ones on this beautiful festive holiday. On behalf of my dear wife Norma, our children and grandchildren, we wish all our members and your dear families a Passover filled with joy and happiness.

The Shomrim Of Philadelphia and The Delaware Valley, regretfully announce the loss of Life Time Member, Past President, Retired Philadelphia Police Captain, and Dear Friend Harold "Blackie" Feinman.

HAROLD "Blackie" Feinman was no doubt the kind of boss lots of people would love to work for.

Harold was a police official, and his officers were his pride and concern.

"He would have gone through hell and high water for his officers," said his son Mark Feinman. "He was very protective of the officers who worked for him."

In fact, Mark said, his father "was very conscientious of how he treated other people, in and out of the Police Department."

Harold Feinman rose through the ranks of the department in his 30-year career to reach the rank of captain before his retirement in 1991. He then moved to Venice. Fla., where he volunteered with the sheriff's office.

He died Sunday of complications of surgery at age 81. He was living in Orlando, Fla.

Harold was an outstanding quarterback at his alma mater, Central High School, from which he graduated in 1949, and later played semipro football with the old Frankford Yellow Jackets.

After a stint selling insurance, he joined the city's Police Department in 1962. He served in numerous districts as a patrol officer and as a detective in the crime-scene unit.

And he was there when some of the city's most notorious crimes occurred, including the MOVE shootout in August 1978 in Powelton Village, during which Officer James J. Ramp was killed, and the destruction of the MOVE house on Osage Avenue in West Philadelphia by a police bomb, which killed 11 people, including five children.

He was also part of the investigation of the case of Harrison "Marty" Graham, who killed seven women in a North Philadelphia crack house in 1987.

Later that year, he took part of the investigation of Gary Heidnik and his "House of Horrors," where he captured five women and killed two. Graham was sentenced to life in prison; Heidnik was executed.

Harold was a founding member of the Vidoq Society, which investigates cold cases from all over the country.

"He was a legend in the Police Department," said his son Jack Feinman, himself a retired police officer. "He was a cop's cop. He liked people. He was very approachable. He pulled many a cop out of the fire. He was bigger than life."

Harold suffered a debilitating stroke in 1981, but he was determined to overcome it. After months of rehabilitation, he was back on the job.

He was also active with the Fraternal Order of Police. He served as treasurer of Philadelphia Lodge 5, and vice president of the state FOP. He was active with the Shomrim Society, the organization of Jewish police officers.

"He was a very straightforward man," said his son Mark, a Philadelphia lawyer. "He wore who he was on his sleeve."

Besides his sons, he is survived by seven daughters, Lynn Feinman, Sherry Pettola, Linda Viviani, Sindi Michalik, Robin Praediger, Ellen Cimorelli and Patricia Perri; another son, Larry; a brother, Selig Feinman; a sister, Barbara Webb; 22 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
