In Memoriam

The week of May 10 has been dedicated as National Police Week. For several years I have been attending and officiating at the Memorial Service in Washington, D.C.

The National Law Enforcement Officer's Memorial was dedicated in 1991 by President George H.W. Bush and is located at Judiciary Square. It honors all of America's federal, state and local law enforcement personnel.

On a blue-gray memorial wall that stands approximately four and a half feet tall and circles the entire park are inscribed the names of more than 1,700 officers who were killed in the line of duty since 1792.

Several photographs of fallen law enforcement personnel line the wall, with patches from various departments throughout the United States, attached to posters, encased by plastic covers to protect them from the rain, describe where the officer served.

Each of the pathway entrances to the memorial is adorned with powerful lions protecting their cubs, depicting the role that police officers play in protecting the communities that they serve.

An inscription on the east wall reads:

"In valor there is hope"

Here in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania we have witnessed over a two year period the senseless murder of nine police officers.

As human beings, we can never make any sense out of the suffering that one human can bring onto another.

Permit me to share with you an anonymous poem.

Not - "How did they die?" But - "How did they live?"

Not - "What did they gain?" But - "What did they give?"

These are the units to measure the worth of officer, regardless of birth.

Not - "What was their station?" But - "Had they a heart?"

and - "How did they play their part?"

"Were they ever ready with a word of good cheer, to bring back a smile, to banish a tear?"

Not - "What was their shrine?" Nor - "What was their creed?"

But - "Had they befriended those really in need?"

Not - "What did the sketch in the newspaper say?"

But - "How many were sorry when they passed away?"

May the memory of all who gave their lives to make our communities a safer place to live, ever be for a blessing.
