As we begin this New Year 5773, let us pray for a year of health, happiness and prosperity for all our members and their dear families.

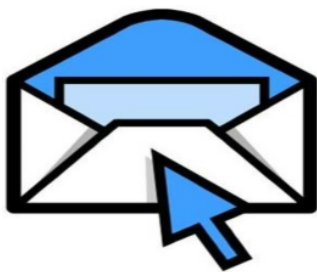

GUEST SPEAKER LARRY O'NEILL'S BIOGRAPHY

LARRY O'NEILL BIOGRAPHY

I retired in January 2010 from the Philadelphia Police Department. I was in my thirtieth year of service and was assigned to the Criminal Intelligence Unit at the time. My career included twelve years in patrol duties, seven years in the Narcotics Field Unit. In 1999 I was asked to work in the recently formed Narcotics Intelligence Squad, where my duties included intel work on gangs in the Philadelphia and surrounding area, including "Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs". About six years ago the police department merged all of their intel units into one – Criminal Intelligence Unit. After the merge my primary responsibility became the OMG's. I have assisted local, state and federal agencies with investigation into the activities of "Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs". During my time working on the bikers I have been an advisor to the History Channels "Gangland" series. I worked on the episodes involving the Outlaws Motorcycle Club and the Pagan's Motorcycle Club. Until my retirement from the Philadelphia Police Department I served on the board of the East Coast Gang Investigators Association (ECGIA). I also wrote the Outlaw Motorcycle Gang section of the Quick Guide to Gangs which was published by the National Alliance of Gang Investigators Associations (NAGIA). After my retirement from the Philadelphia Police Department I accepted a position as the Law Enforcement Coordinator for MAGLOCLIN (Middle Atlantic Great Lakes Organized Crime Law Enforcement Network) covering the eastern area of Pennsylvania. I have held this position for the last 3 years.
